- (5) The restriction of DEHP, BBP and DBP shall not apply to toys which are already subject to the restriction of DEHP, BBP and DBP through entry 51 of Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.'

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

- 3) These samples were dissolved totally by pre-conditioning method according to below flow chart (Cr6+ and PBBs/PBDEs test method excluded).





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
